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Rules for the Arts and Crafts, Non-profit and Commercial Vendors

Please DO NOT drive on the asphalt paths within the park!
These surfaces were designed for foot traffic only.

Park Access and Check-In

- 🍏 All vendors must check in with a vendor staff member before setting up. Staff will direct you to your assigned booth space. The vendor information booth will be located at the east end of the upper park.
- 🍏 Friday check-in and setup begin at 12:00 noon and continue until dusk. Saturday check-in and setup begin at 6:00 AM.
- 🍏 All unloading must be completed and all vehicles must be moved out of the park by 8:30 AM. Booths must be fully set up and ready to open by 9:00 AM and remain open until 5:00 PM.

Booth Setup and Weather Preparation

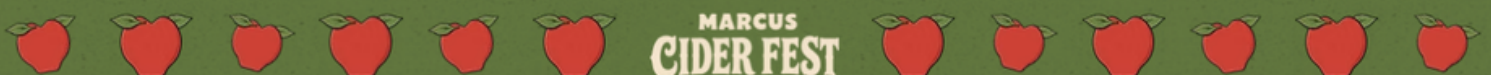
- 🍏 Vendors must provide their own booth, displays, and weather protection. All displays must remain within the assigned booth space and should not obstruct visitors' views of neighboring exhibitors.
- 🍏 Because Marcus Cider Fest is held outdoors in the fall, vendors should prepare for wind, rain, and colder temperatures. Booths, canopies, tarps, merchandise, and displays should be secured appropriately. Please clearly mark all stakes, ropes, and tie-downs to help prevent tripping hazards.

Overnight Security

- 🍏 Vendors who leave merchandise, money, or equipment in their booths overnight are responsible for securing those items. Marcus Cider Fest does not provide overnight security and cannot be responsible for loss, theft, or damage.

Electricity

- 🍏 Vendors requesting electricity will be assigned space in the lower park. Booth locations with electrical access are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 🍏 Electrical cords are not provided. Vendors should bring their own extension cords, with a recommended length of 50 to 100 feet.





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Rules for the Arts and Crafts, Non-profit and Commercial Vendors Continued

Cleanup, Permits, and Sales Tax

- 🍏 Vendors are responsible for keeping their booth area clean and free of garbage, cords, equipment, and other tripping hazards.
- 🍏 Each vendor is responsible for obtaining any required permits or licenses and for collecting applicable Washington sales tax at the booth.

RVs and Overnight Camping

- 🍏 RVs are permitted along the outside row of the upper park when they fit entirely behind the assigned booth space.
- 🍏 Free dry camping is available overnight in designated vendor parking areas.

Generators

- 🍏 Generators are permitted, but they must operate quietly and should not disturb visitors or nearby vendors. Vendors may be asked to turn off a generator if the noise becomes disruptive.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read, understand, and agree to comply with all terms, conditions, and vendor rules established by the Marcus Cider Fest Association and the Town of Marcus.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Marcus Cider Fest Association and the Town of Marcus from any claims, losses, costs, damages, citations, towing expenses, or other liabilities arising from any accident, incident, or occurrence related to my participation or exhibitor location.

I understand that neither the Marcus Cider Fest Association nor the Town of Marcus is responsible for the theft, loss, or damage of merchandise, equipment, money, or personal property before, during, or after the festival. Neither organization is responsible for any loss of sales, inventory, or income caused by weather, theft, damage, or any other incident.
